


8. Detail Description of the Event:





There are 20 enthusiastic participants in the program from the department of physics and Mathematics. Each participant was given the freedom to ask questions.


7. Outcome:


5. Detail description of the event:

There are 20 enthusiastic participants in the program from the department of physics and Mathematics. Each participant was given the freedom to ask questions.


